Wanda (Powell) Moore of Decatur, Arkansas passed away on April 14, 2016 at Siloam Springs Nursing and Rehab at the age of 87 after battling COPD and pneumonia. 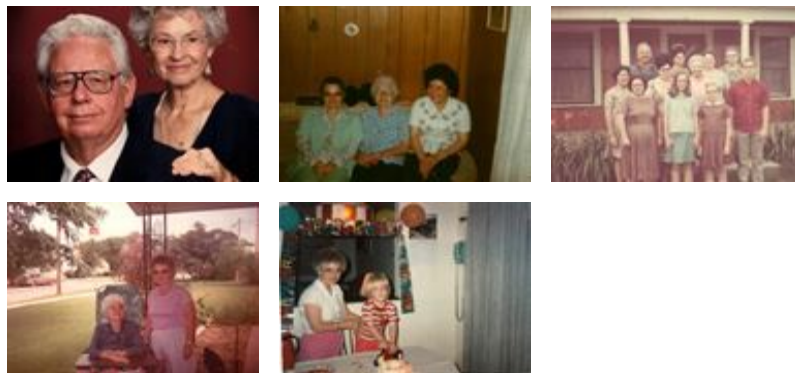
