Warren Eugene "Dusty" Rogers, 55, of Rose, Oklahoma, died Saturday May 17, 2014, at his home. Born June 13, 1958, in Pryor, Oklahoma, he was the son of Robert Eugene and Faye Aylene Haegert Rogers. 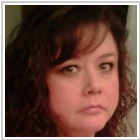
