Above all else, Willa cherished her role as a mother, grandmother, and great-grandmother. She loved her children deeply and found immense joy in spending time with her grandchildren and great-grandchildren. Her home was always filled with warmth, laughter, music—and above all—love.

Those who knew Willa remember her as someone who never spoke a harsh word. Her sweetness touched everyone around her; she had many friends who treasured her companionship over the years. Her legacy is one of kindness, service, faith, and love—a legacy that will live on through all who had the privilege of knowing her.

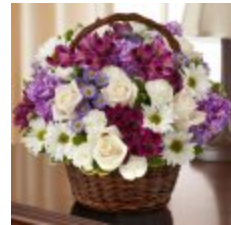

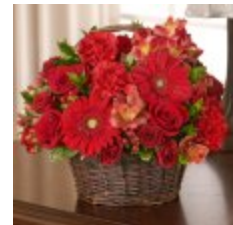
