December 21, 1920 - March 9, 2006

William Kenneth "Ken" Blair, 85 year-old resident of Twin Oaks, Oklahoma, died March 9, 2006, at Siloam Springs Memorial Hospital, Siloam Springs, Arkansas. Born December 21, 1920 in Noble, Oklahoma, he was the son of H. J. Blair and Katherine Meares Blair. He was a graduate of Althus High School in Altus, Oklahoma. He lived most of his life in Northwest Arkansas and was an Army Veteran of World War II. He was a survivor of the Battle of the Bulge and Hurricane Forrest and was decorated many times, receiving 3 bronze medals. Survivors include his wife Helen M. Blair of the home; one foster daughter, Juanita Grover of West Fork, Arkansas; and three nephews. Funeral services will be 2:00 p.m., Saturday, March 11, 2006, at Wasson Memorial Chapel, Siloam Springs, Arkansas. Burial will follow at Oak Hill Cemetery, Siloam Springs, Arkansas.
