William "Bill" Hix Hendren, 78 year-old resident of Colcord, Oklahoma, died February 26, 2008, at Siloam Springs Memorial Hospital, Siloam Springs, Arkansas. Born December 13, 1929 in Colcord, Oklahoma, he was the son of Albert Hendren and Mattie Potter Hendren. He was an Army Veteran of World War II.
