



W.W. "Woody" Brown

November 13, 1916 - April 8, 2013

W.W. "Woody" Brown, 96, of Rogers, Arkansas, died April 8, 2013, at Innisfree Health and Rehab, Rogers, Arkansas. Born November 13, 1916, in Beaver County, Oklahoma, he was the son of Joseph Barton Brown and Frances Parle Girdner Brown. He graduated from Laverne High School, Laverne, Oklahoma in 1936. He was baptized as a teenager at Fairview Methodist Church and worked on the Alexander Ranch in Beaver County until 1939. On November 12, 1939, Woody married Connie Flock. For 30 years they lived in Darrouzett, Texas, where they owned a grocery store and Woody farmed and ranched. He also served on the school board in Darrouzett.

He was always happiest working with his animals or working on new inventions in his shop. In later years, he enjoyed trail rides and the people he met there. Woody also lived in Anderson, Missouri, and Siloam Springs, Arkansas prior to moving to Rogers. He was a member of the Quarter Horse Association, and the United Methodist Church.

He was preceded in death by his parents and three brothers, Bill Brown, Burl Brown, and James Buster Brown.

Survivors include his wife Connie of the home; one son, Teddy Brown and wife Norma of Siloam Springs, Arkansas; two grandchildren, Teddi Gail Blagg and husband Donnie of Fayetteville, Arkansas, and Craig Brown of Siloam

Springs.
